The championship is organised by the National School Sport Union of France (Union Nationale du Sport Scolaire - UNSS) according to International School Sport Federation competition rules.

1. Participation and composition of groups.

The draw took place on 14th January 2013 at the City Hall of Bordeaux in the presence of Guy Fusenig, ISF Treasurer, Laurent Petrynka, National Director of the UNSS, Arielle Piazza, Deputy Mayor of the city of Bordeaux, Konrad Berchtold, President of the ISF Technical Commission Football, Hasan Ceylan, Assessor at the ISF Executive Committee and Christophe Sarre, member of the ISF Technical Commission Football.

2. International Get-together (Nations' Night)

Delegations are required to take part in an evening “**International Get-together**” organised with the aim of encouraging exchanges between the different cultures of participating countries. The young people are invited to introduce and to promote their countries and their culture in an original way. Each delegation is to organise a stand at the “Tourist Fair” on the theme ‘Suppose you came to spend your holidays in my country’. This presentation may be made in the form of leaflets, video, CD, photos or other original ideas, for example by offering a taste of typical culinary specialities (dishes, drinks, ...).

On addition each delegation may, if it wishes, introduce a facet of its country’s culture on stage (the stage is yours – dance, songs, sketches ...) maximum 4 minutes.

Countries with a presentation on stage have to inform the OC in advance and must present the music to be used on CD or USB, as well as countries presenting a film.

4. Board, Lodging and Services.

- 4.1. All the students with their coaches, the head of delegations, the additional adults and the ISF representatives will be accommodated in one of this hotel accommodations; All Suit Park Hotel, Etap Hotel, Ibis, Inter Hotel Apolonia, Novotel, Première Classe and Village du Lac.
- 4.2. All meals will be taken at a single site "Espace du Lac", centrally situated with regard to the sports venue and the hotels. Les Saveurs d'Evénements will be responsible for catering.
- 4.3. The price of an additional meal on the arrival or departure day will be 22€.
- 4.4. The competition will take place at the sports venue "Colette Besson".
The matches will be played on 10 grass pitches (smallest 100 x 60m). For any training there will be 4 pitches with artificial grass available. These pitches must be allocated by the OC.
The final game will take place at the "St-Germaine au Bouscat Stadium".
- 4.5. The opening ceremony will take place at the Bordeaux Stadium Vélodrome.
The closing ceremony will take place at l'Espace du Lac.
- 4.6. A medical service will be available throughout the duration of the Championship.
- 4.7. A laundry service is offered at 5 € per complete outfit (shorts, jersey, socks).
It is recommended that the teams bring 3 sets of jerseys.
- 4.8. Internet is available in public WIFI areas (at least at the accommodations).

5. Finances and Insurance.

- 5.1. The fees payable per person and per night amount to 44 EUR in accordance with current ISF regulations. The amount due per person is 352 EUR, less the amount of the deposit previously paid.
- 5.2. The Organising Committee **prefers that the balance of the sum due be paid in EUR to the ORGANISERS' BANK ACCOUNT** by 10/03/2013 at the latest:

All bank charges are the responsibility of the delegations.

OR

Only in exceptional cases the balance of the sum shall be paid in cash (EUR) by the Head of Delegation on arrival. Payment by bank and /or credit cards will not be accepted.

- 5.3 The OC can accommodate each person above the authorised quota with his/her delegation at the daily rate of 88 € per person.
- 5.4. Each member of the delegation must pay an ISF levy of 30 EUR in accordance with current ISF regulations. This sum is to be paid to the Organising Committee before the start of the competition. Cash on arrival or preferably by bank transfer beforehand.
- 5.5. Delegations, which are unable to provide the required number of National or International referees, must pay a fine of 907 EUR per missing referee.
Referees must present their national/international referee's licence for inspection.

6. Technical information.

The official competition ball (the brand is Nike) will be size 5 for boys and girls.
The OC will make balls available to each team for training and warm-up.
The OC has at its disposal 120 balls for warming up and 50 match balls.

7. Communication.

All further information and each day's results along with important information from the OC will be published in the daily bulletins of the organisers and on the ISF website www.isfsports.org and organisers website www.mondial-football.wix.com/2013.
The Heads of Delegation will have the possibility to download information with an USB stick.

8. Control Commission.

- 8.1. In accordance with General Competition Rules the Organising Committee will designate a Control Commission composed of :
 - 6 representatives of the ISF Technical Commission Football,
 - 2 representatives of the OC
- 8.2. At accreditation, the Head of Delegation must settle with the organisers the balance to be paid including any bank charges and will present the following documents to the Control Commission :
 - proof of payment of the balance including any bank charges,
 - the passport (or identity card) of every player bearing family name, first name, photograph, nationality and date of birth,
 - a letter from the school confirming that all players are full time students at the school, since the beginning of the school year.

When checking is complete, each participant will receive an accreditation card which allow him/her access to the competition, activities and meals.

9. Disciplinary Commission.

- 9.1. In accordance with the ISF General Competition Rules, the Disciplinary Commission will be composed of :

- the Delegate representing the ISF Executive Committee
- the President of the ISF Technical Commission Football
- the President of the Organising Committee

The Disciplinary Commission will deal with all matters relating to discipline arising during the championship matches and also during the period of the Championship where the matters are not covered by technical regulations.

9.2. The Disciplinary Commission's decisions are final. They are passed on to the Executive Committee.

9.3. It should be noted that where there is a sufficiently serious lack of respect for ISF rules the Disciplinary Commission could disqualify participants, teams or delegations from the competition and to require them to return home before the conclusion of the event.

10. Appeal Jury.

10.1. In accordance with the ISF General Competition Rules; the Appeal Jury will composed of:

- a representative of the ISF Technical Commission Football
- a representative of the Organising Committee
- a representative of the referees

10.2. The Appeal Jury will decide on all appeals concerning the results of the competition in the light of the rules of FIFA and the rules of the ISF Technical Commission Football.

10.3. The Appeal Jury will not pronounce on disciplinary matters.

10.4. Appeal Jury decisions are final and may not be appealed.

11. Appeals.

11.1. Appeals against results or any other appeal not concerning disciplinary matters will be heard by the Appeal Jury.

11.2. The appeal must be lodged within 30 minutes of the incident and be in writing in English, French or German.

11.3. The sum of 75 EUR must accompany the appeal. This sum will be refunded only if the appeal is upheld or at the discretion of the Appeal Jury.

12. Obligations undertaken by delegations.

12.1. Each participant is required to be present throughout the duration of the event.

12.2. Each participant is obliged to take part in all of the non-sport activities.

12.3. Each team undertakes to compete against all other participating teams.

12.4. Each participant undertakes to compete against all other participants.



12.5. The absence of any member of a participating team from any part of the entire sport programme, opening-, prize-giving-, and closing ceremonies and socio-cultural programme may result in the disqualification of that team.

14. Registration.

The ELECTRONIC ENTRY REGISTRATION FORM 3 should be duly completed on behalf of the Organisation responsible for school sport at the latest by 10th March 2013.

Registration through ISF's new ERAS (Electronic Registration and Accreditation System) will be open from 15th February 2013 via the ISF website www.isfsports.org.

To get access to the registration, you will have to fill in username and password which will be sent by separate e-mail together with some more detailed information for registration.
